
1) A Courtesy Visit of the Registrar, IIPA, New Delhi.

4) The Late Dr. S.S. Gadkari Memorial Award for Innovation in Public Administration:

The Regional Branch received a donation of ₹ 50,000/-from Ms. Sandhya Gadkari-Sharma d/o Late Dr. S.S. Gadkari, former Executive Joint Secretary IIPA/MRB, in March, 2015. As desired by the donor, a corpus fund of ₹ 50,000/- in the name of S.S. Gadkari has been set-up by the Regional Branch.

The Regional Branch has instituted "The Late Dr. S.S. Gadkari Annual Memorial Award for Innovation in Public Administration" since 2016.

This award is given to the public servant of the State Government who does excellent work on developing innovative ideas for delivering public service/public governance related to his/her office.

The criteria set for the award is primarily the employee having developed an idea which is innovative, by using the cutting-edge technology, which proved to be efficient, effective, time saving, transparent, citizen centric and hassle free for delivering the public service to the citizens. The innovation must be within the existing Rules & Regulations and office frame work. The said innovative system should be adoptable and is being successfully implemented in the office.

A committee under the Chairmanship of the Hony. Chairman, IIPA/MRB comprising Hony. Secretary, IIPA/MRB and Chief Secretary, GAD (AIE & GG) - as members have been constituted for adjudging the proposals and selection of the nominee.

Award of 10,000/- and a certificate of appreciation is presented to the awardee. We also reimburse travelling expenses (limited to A/C three tier Railway or A/C Bus fare) to the outstation awardee.

Award for 2025:

This is the 10th year of the Award. The Regional Branch had called nominations for this Award from the heads of various departments of the State Government. The Regional Branch had received a total of 30 proposals submitted by various authorities of the State before the last date fixed for submitting the proposals.

The committee met on 5th & 6th June 2025 as per time slots given to officers, heard their proposals individually through Video conferencing to evaluate the proposals received. After careful scrutiny of the proposals and considering criteria set for the award, committee recommended as follows:

- 1) The Award may be given to MARVEL CEO Shri Harssh Poddar, IPS, for the implementation of MARVEL which drives the adoption of Artificial Intelligence in Law Enforcement, enhances public administration, inter-agency collaboration and service delivery. This innovation will help governance and public administration in various sectors.
- 2) The Award may be given to Smt. Ashima Mittal, IAS. CEO ZP, Nashik, for the implementation of the Educational Innovations in Rural Areas are unique and praiseworthy:
 - A) JEE, NEET Coaching for students from Rural areas,
 - B) Mission Atmanirbhar for Divyang students,
 - C) Spelling Bee and
 - D) Digitization of Zilla Parishad Schools

Smt. Ashima Mittal has worked relentlessly to improve educational standards in rural areas of Nashik District.

The Committee was of unanimous opinion that Shri Harssh Poddar, IPS, MARVEL CEO & Smt. Ashima Mittal, IAS. CEO ZP, Nashik, both deserved to be awarded.

The Award is to be presented in the ensuing 70thAGM of the Regional Branch.

5) Library:

The Regional Branch has well-maintained library having more than 8000 plus books on various subjects of Public Administration including Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Management, History, Biographies of eminent personalities and books written by Service and defence personnel. 
